## **TEACHER INSTRUCTIONS**

- Assign Timur Kuran's article "Now Out of Never: The Element of Surprise in the East European Revolution of 1989."
- Make sure to carefully explain the roles that "preference falsification" and 'revolutionary thresholds' play in revolutonary cascades.
- Cut out the profile strips and distribute among the class. There are 15 profiles here but you can adapt for different class sizes.
- Give the students a minute to read and inhabit their profile.

## **SCRIPT FOR CLASS**

I will take the role of the Utrilian security forces. You each have an identity explained by your slips of paper. If the circumstances and your role insturctions demand that you "take to the streets" as the game progresses, come forward to the front of the class.

When I make the following signal (make punching movement), that means I'm beating someone.

I'm now going to read a very short narrative.

Utril is a personalist authoritarian regime run by the brutal dictator Drita Agim. Freedom House scores Utril as "Not Free." On the Spinal Tap authoritarian scale, Utril goes to 11.

In March 2018, a rumor spreads throughout Utril that, Kostadin Agnesa, a leader of the opposition group The Brotherhood has been tortured to death by security forces. You assume this rumor is true.

[A student will come to the front of the class shouting loudly. Ask their name and then 'beat them.']

There will now be a gap—Express your anger at how ungrateful your subjects are and kick a dog [The purpose here is to show that something that seems relatively innocuous—not to diminish animal cruelty—can trigger a revolutionary cascade. Thus, Kuran's 'element of surprise.']

## STUDENT PROFILES
